

2018 Dos Pueblos Invitational

Dos Pueblos Invitational is a high school cross country meet with grade-level (9th, 10th, 11th, 12th) races for boys and girls in a beautiful park setting next to the Pacific Ocean with views of the Santa Barbara Riviera.

Where: Chase Palm Park – 236 East Cabrillo Blvd, Santa Barbara, CA 93101

Course Description: The course is on the grass parkway next to the beach along East Cabrillo Blvd between Chase Palm Park and East Beach. Start and finish are in the large field near Chase Palm Park. The course goes from there to East Beach and back twice. The course is entirely on grass. It does not use the sidewalk along Cabrillo Blvd or the bike path along the beach.

Team areas: Can be on the grass near the start/finish.
Please clean up your team area when you leave.

Timing/Results. By SB Timing using timing chips. Roster with competitor numbers and chips will be in the team packet (see entry info below). Runners should write their number on hand/arm as back-up. Chips to be removed from runners at the finish. Coaches must return unused chips to the finish area. Results to be posted at the meet and online at www.dpicrosscountry.com after the meet.

Scoring and Awards:

Scoring: Team score in each race is the sum of the places of a team's first three finishers.

First 20 finishers in each race will receive lapel pins.

First and second team in each race will be awarded plaques.

Perennial sweepstakes trophies are awarded for Boys and Girls teams.

A team's sweepstake score is the sum of their best three scores from the four the grade level races. But a team must have a complete team (3 finishers) in all 4 grade level races to qualify for the sweepstake trophy.

T-Shirts and Snacks will be available for purchase at the meet. Please remind your team to bring cash for these items if they are interested. .

Directions:

From US 101 (north or south): Take Garden Street exit and turn away from the mountains. Garden ends at East Cabrillo Blvd. Either go straight through the traffic light into the beachside

pay parking lot, or make a left turn onto Cabrillo and park along the street. The start/finish area is in the large grass field next to 236 E. Cabrillo Blvd.

Parking Spectators can park in the beach side pay lots at Chase Palm Park or East Beach. Buy a parking ticket at the kiosk and place on your dashboard. Or park along East Cabrillo Blvd.

Buses may drop off and pick up athletes in the lot adjacent to the park, but may not park there. Buses are to park at Santa Barbara City College lot #3. Take Cabrillo west past Stearns Wharf and the harbor. At the SB City College stadium, make a right on Loma Alta and immediate left into the parking lot across the street from the stadium. The back of the lot will be coned off for DPI bus parking.

Portable Restrooms We ask that athletes use the portable restrooms near the start/finish area rather than the public park restrooms, because the park is still open to park-goers during the race.

Garbage/Recycling: Please be mindful of the garbage around your team's area and be sure that it is disposed of properly.

Entry Fees: The cost is \$275 for an entire team (boys and girls) or \$12 per individual. The break-even is at 22 runners. If you have more than 22, your entry fee is \$275.
