Course

Start, finish, meet headquarters, and awards on the grassy area overlooking Ledbetter Beach at east end of Shoreline Park. The course makes two out and back loops on the grass to west end of the park with a loop down the hill to Ledbetter Beach in between. *Keep flags and cones on your right* at all times. The course crosses but does not go on walkways of the park. Please keep walkways clear in respect to the local residents who love to walk in the park everyday.

Open Community Race

Following the high school races, we will be hosting an open community race for the first time. Race participants will be able to put their affiliation while signing up (Dos Pueblos Alumni, San Marcos Coach, Buchanan Parent, etc.) and this race will be scored cross country style (top 3 score, with 1 runner displacing). This race is a fundraiser for DPXC, so there will be a small \$10 entry fee to run this race. *Coaches of participating teams may run for free.* Runners can sign up on race day at the timing tent.

Fees: The cost is \$275 for an entire team (boys and girls) or \$12 per runner. Please make checks payable to Dos Pueblos High School or 'DPHS'. Checks will be accepted on race day, or you can mail them to:

Parking

Buses may park at Santa Barbara City College or at Dos Pueblos High School (12 miles from the race site). Spectators can park in the city lot at Leadbetter Beach, in the City College lots if they obtain a parking permit. To minimize our impact on local residents we ask that all spectators please avoid parking in the neighborhoods across from the park. There is no parking allowed on Shoreline Drive alongside the park!
